

May Allah (SWT) continue to guide all of our students on their paths of knowledge and imaan. Ameen!



What has the ISB Council been working on recently? And who are the new faces joining our leadership team?


Alhamdulilah, our recent General Body Meeting was a great success, as we introduced the newly elected Council members to the community.
