

Record-breaking attendance for our Ramadan Open House, where non-Muslim neighbors experienced Ramadan at the masjid!


Dozens of visitors visited the masjid and were led on a tour, joined a Q&A session with

Your support, by the will of Allah (SWT), continues to make ISB a safer and more welcoming place for all.


